
Hope Lutheran Chapel Communion Statement: If you are a confirmed member in good standing of a LCMS or an AALC congregation, are repentant of your sins, and believe Jesus gives you His true body and blood for the forgiveness of your sins in the Lord's Supper, you are welcome to commune with us today. (I Cor. 11:17-32) For Lutherans, receiving the Lord's Supper, is an action of the celebrating community, signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. (I Cor. 10:14-22, 11:18-19, 26; Eph. 4:2-6) If you are a visitor from another Christian Church body or other faith, we welcome you to our service. As a sad consequence of the divisions in Christianity we cannot extend to you a general invitation to the Lord's Supper. Reception of the Lord's Supper by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray. If you are a visitor and not sure whether or not you should commune, please speak with the Pastor, Elder, or Usher before the service.

Communion Note: For those who need assistance with the cup please hold out your hand and the Elder will hand it to you.

If it is difficult for you to kneel at the rail, please feel free to remain standing.





10.

1 John 4:7-16

Dear friends, let us love one another because love comes from God and everyone who loves is God's child and knows God. He who doesn't love hasn't learned to know God, because God is Love. God has shown us His love by sending His only-begotten Son into the world for us to live through Him. This is love, not that we loved God but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the payment for our sins. Dear friends, if that's how God loved us, then we should love one another. No one has ever seen God. If we love one another, God lives in us, and His love has accomplished in us what He wants. This is how we know we live in Him and He in us: He has given us His Spirit. HOLY GOSPEL LESSON

Matthew 1:18-25

P The Holy Gospel according to St. Matthew, the first chapter.



This is how Jesus Christ was born. His mother Mary had promised Joseph to be his wife. But before they came together, it was found that she was going to have a child-by the Holy Spirit. Joseph, her husband, was a righteous man and didn't want to disgrace her. So he decided to divorce her secretly. After he thought about it, he saw an angel of the Lord in a dream, who said, "Joseph, son of David, don't be afraid to take your wife Mary home with you; her Child is from the Holy Spirit. She will have a Son, and you will call Him Jesus, because He will save His people from their sins." All this happened so that what the Lord said through the prophet would come true: "The virgin will conceive and have a Son, and He will he called Immanuel," which means "Godwith-us." When Joseph awoke, he did what the Lord's angel had ordered him to do. He took his wife home with him but didn't have relations with her until she had a son. And he called Him Jesus.

the Lord and giver of life,


who proceeds from the Father and the Son,
