

The Lord sends out His ministers of the Gospel to make disciples "of all the nations," so that "all the ends of the earth shall see the salvation of our God." The Lord has "bared his holy arm" in the incarnate Christ (Is. 52:7, 10). The child in the manger, born of the Virgin Mary, is the very Word of God, the only begotten Son of the Father, "whom he appointed the heir of all things, through whom also he created the world" (Heb. 1:2). As "all things were made through him" (John 1:3), so are all things redeemed and made new in Him. EPISTLE LESSON

Hebrews 1:1-6 (7-12)

At many times and in many ways, God spoke to our fathers long ago by the prophets, but in these last days He has spoken to us by His Son, Whom He made the heir of everything and by Whom He made the world. He Who shines with God's glory and is the Expression of His Being sustains everything by His mighty Word. He made a cleansing from sins, sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven, and is as much superior than angels as the name He has is better than theirs. To which of the angels did God ever say: You are My Son, today I have begotten You? Or again: I will be His Father, and He will be My Son? And when He again will bring the firstborn Son into the world, He says: All of God's angels should worship Him. He says of the angels: He makes His angels winds and His servants fiery flames. But to the Son He says: Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, and You rule Your kingdom with a scepter of righteousness. You have loved right and hated wrong. That is why God, Your God, has put You above Your companions by anointing You with the oil of joy. And: Lord, in the beginning You laid the foundation of the earth and Your hands made the heavens! They will perish, but You continue. They will all become old like a garment. You will roll them up like a blanket, and like a garment they will be changed. But You are the same, and Your years will never end.

HOLY GOSPEL LESSON

John 1:1-14 (15-18)

- P The Holy Gospel according to St. John, the first chapter.
- Glory be to Thee, O Lord.

IN THE BEGINNING WAS THE WORD, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God. Everything was made by Him, and not one thing that was made was made without Him. In Him was life, and the Life was the Light of men. The Light is shining in the dark, and the darkness has not put it out. A man came - God sent him - his name was John. He came to tell the truth about the Light so that through him everyone might believe. He was not the Light but came to tell the truth about the Light. The true Light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world. He was in the world, and He made the world, and the world didn't know Him. He came to His own, and His own people didn't welcome Him. But to all who welcomed Him, who believe in His name, He gave the right to become God's children. They have been born, not of the blood of parents, nor of a sexual desire, nor of a man's desire, but of God. And the Word became flesh and lived among us for a time and we saw His glory, the glory of the only-begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth. John told the truth about Him when he called: "This is the One of Whom I said, He Who is coming after me is ahead of me because He was before me." All of us have taken from all that is in Him – gift after gift of His love. The Law was given through Moses, but Jesus Christ brought grace and truth. No one has ever seen God. The one-and-only Son Who is God, Who is close to the Father's heart, has made Him known.
