

Hope Lutheran Chapel Communion Statement: If you are a confirmed member in good standing of a LCMS or an AALC congregation, are repentant of your sins, and believe Jesus gives you His true body and blood for the forgiveness of your sins in the Lord's Supper, you are welcome to commune with us today. (I Cor. 11:17-32) For Lutherans, receiving the Lord's Supper, is an action of the celebrating community, signifying a oneness in faith, life, and worship of the community. (I Cor. 10:14-22, 11:18-19, 26; Eph. 4:2-6) If you are a visitor from another Christian Church body or other faith, we welcome you to our service. As a sad consequence of the divisions in Christianity we cannot extend to you a general invitation to the Lord's Supper. Reception of the Lord's Supper by Christians not fully united with us would imply a oneness which does not yet exist, and for which we must all pray. If you are a visitor and not sure whether or not you should commune, please speak with the Pastor, Elder, or Usher before the service.



The Son of God, Christ Jesus, Makes Us a New Creation Isaiah 40:21–31 ~ 1 Corinthians 9:16–27 ~ Mark 1:29–39

The Lord alone "is the everlasting God, the Creator of the ends of the earth" (Is. 40:28). He "sits above the circle of the earth" and "stretches out the heavens like a curtain" (Is. 40:22). Yet, His almighty power is demonstrated chiefly by His mercy and compassion. "He gives power to the faint, and to him who has no might he increases strength" (Is. 40:29). The only begotten Son of the Father, the very Word by whom all things were made, becomes flesh and takes all the poverty and weakness of our sin and death upon Himself, bearing it in His body to the cross. As He dies for us there, He also raises us up, a new creation, in His resurrection from the dead. Thus, by the preaching of this Word, He heals "many who were sick with various diseases," and He casts out "many demons" (Mark 1:34, 39). And His preaching continues through those whom He has sent, who are "entrusted with a stewardship" to "preach the gospel" (1 Cor. 9:16–17). Thus, we are set free by the Word of Christ, and we exercise our freedom in loving service to others.

OLD TESTAMENT LESSON

Isaiah 40:21-31

Don't you know? Didn't you hear? Haven't you been told from the beginning? Don't you understand how the earth was made? He is on His throne above the circle of the earth, and those who live on it are like grasshoppers. He stretches out the sky like a curtain and spreads it like a tent for people to live under it. He reduces princes to nothing and makes the rulers of the earth worthless. Hardly have they been planted,

hardly have they been sown, hardly has their stem taken root in the ground, when He blows at them and they wither, and a whirlwind takes them away like straw. "Is there anyone you can compare Me with and who is equal to Me?" asks the Holy One. Look up high and see! Who made these? Who brings out their army by number? He calls them all by name. Because He is so strong and powerful, not one star is missing. Jacob, why do you complain? Israel, why do you say, "What happens to me is hidden from the LORD; my God fails to treat me fairly?" Don't you know? Didn't you hear? The everlasting God, the LORD who made the whole earth, doesn't get tired or weary. No one can by searching find out what He knows. He gives strength to the weary and provides vigor to those who have none. Young men get tired and weary; in spite of their young vigor, they may fall exhausted; but those who depend on the LORD get new strength. They lift up their wings like eagles; they run and don't get tired; they walk and don't get weary.

EPISTLE LESSON

1 Corinthians 9:16-27

If I tell the good news, I have nothing to boast about. I must tell it. Woe to me if I don't tell the good news! If I do it because I want to, I get a reward. But if I don't want to do it, I still have this work entrusted to me. What then is my reward? Just this: When I tell the good news, I won't let it cost anyone anything, and so I won't take advantage of my right in telling the good news. Although I am free from all people, I made myself a slave of all of them to win more of them. To the Jews I became like a Jew to win Jews; to those under the Law I became like a man under the Law—although I'm not under the Law-to win those under the Law. To those who don't have the Law I became like a man without the Law—although I'm not outside the Law of God but under the law of Christ—to win those who don't have the Law. To weak persons I became weak to win the weak. I've been everything to everyone so that in every way I might save some of them. I'm doing everything for the good news in order to have a share of what it gives. Don't you know that all who are in a race run but only one wins the prize? Like them, run to win! Anyone who enters a contest goes into strict training. Now, they do it to win a wreath that withers, but we do it to win one that never withers. So I run with a clear goal ahead of me. I fight and don't just shadow box. No, I beat my body and make it my slave so that, when I've called others to run the race, I myself will not somehow be disqualified.

Mark 1:29-39


